Arriving by car?

From the A4 The Hague direction towards Amsterdam

- From the A4 The Hague direction towards Amsterdam
- Take exit 1 Sloten (S107).
- At the end of the exit, turn right onto Anderlechtlaan (S107).
- Continue to the Oude Haagseweg.
- After the petrol station on the left, turn left (you will drive under a metro viaduct).
- Follow this road with a bend to the right (Thomas R. Malthusstraat) and turn left onto



Keynesplein.

- The entrance to the car park is to the left of the Dutch Design Hotel Artemis.
- The 'Say Building' is located at John M. Keynesplein 1-27. You can check in at reception.

From other directions / Ring A10

- Take exit 1 (S107) and follow the signs for Sloten/Slotervaart.
- Drive to the end of the Henk Sneevlietweg.
- At the T-junction, turn left onto Johan Huizingalaan (S107).
- After 500 metres, turn right onto David Ricardostraat. You will pass the Say Building (on your left).
- At the T-junction, turn right and then immediately left, passing Hotel Artemis.
- The entrance to the car park is to the left of the Dutch Design Hotel Artemis.
- The 'Say Building' is located at John M. Keynesplein 1-27. You can check in at reception.

Arriving by public transport?

- There are several ways to get to our office by public transport.
- However, the best way to reach our officeis to travel to the NS train station Amsterdam Zuid or Amsterdam Lelylaan and then take Metro line 50 to the Henk Sneevlietweg stop.
- At the Henk Sneevlietweg exit there is a bus stop where you can catch the Rieker Business Park shuttle bus service.
- The Rieker Circle Line runs on weekdays between 7:00 and 20:00. It runs every 8 minutes during peak hours and every 15 minutes during off-peak hours. For more information this service, please visit: https://www.gvb.nl/en/travel-information/line/GVB/68
- Exit the bus at the John M. Keynesplein stop.
