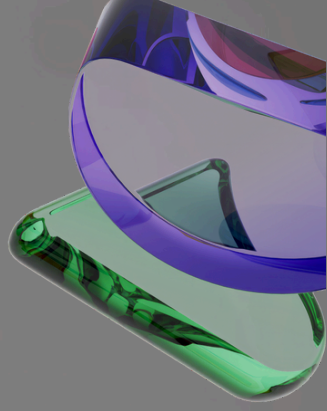

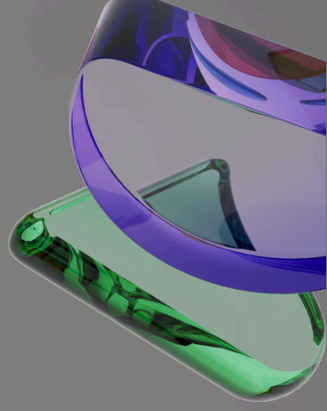
Dr. Jacqui Taylor

Jarmo Eskelinen

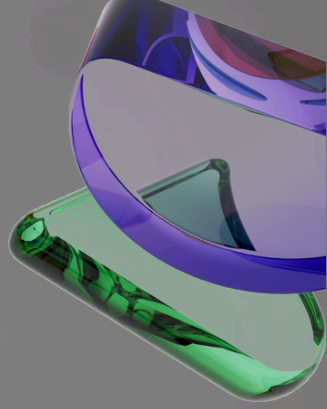
Executive Director, Data Driven Innovation Initiative
