1. Once the primary setup is complete, you will be presented with the logon screen. Press the enter key to continue.

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2. Accept the legal notice when presented with this screen by pressing OK.



 If your WIFi needs connecting this can be connected here by selecting the WIFI icon and selecting your access point from the list and entering the appropriate password.



4. Enter your BSI credentials to login.

Note: this is your BSI email address and password.





5. You will be presented with this screen. Do not power off your laptop.

 On your next login you may begin accessing your apps. At some stage (up to 15 mins later) you will be prompted to enter a BitLocker pin. Bitlocker is another security measure and on every boot of the device, you will be required to remember this pin.

Note: The BitLocker pin must be a minimum of 8 characters, numerical only and not contain any sequential numbers.
